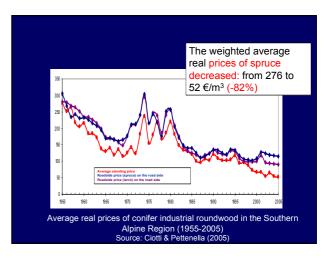


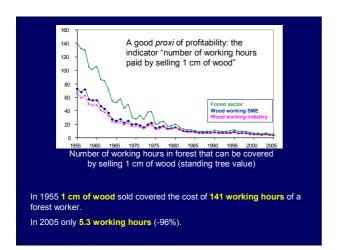






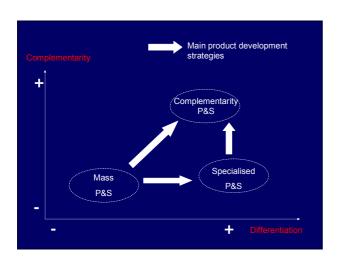




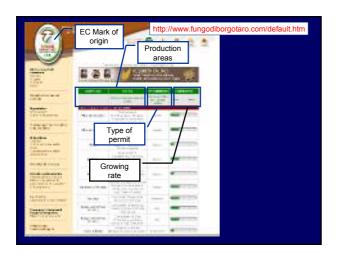


Two of the pillars of the mountain economy are collapsing

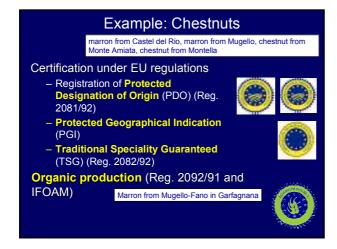
An increasing role is played by traditional and new NWFP&S linked to tourism, recreation, sport, cultural activities



1. Specialized products and services Typically products and services well differentiated, often available in relatively limited quantities (e.g. specialities like truffles). Important instruments for product/service differentiation: - quality assurance - standardisation - certification they give the possibility of premium prices.









2. Complementary products and services

= those products that can be sold and used in strict association with other, due to the synergies deriving from their conjoint marketing.
